Freshers.

There were two freshers' events for Disabled Students; both went very well indeed. The first session was a Facebook chat that ran very smoothly, and there were quite a few students who attended.

The second was an Adobe Connect session. For this we had Andy Broadbent, the CEO of BroadbentCo, a DSA advisory company. He was there to answer questions from students surrounding DSA England. This was an event mainly for students based in England, and due to differing rules, there are others planned for other nations.

Social Media
