STUDENT SATISFACTION IMPROVEMENT ACTION PLAN

The CEC is asked to:-

 discuss ideas to feed into the Action Plan for the Student Satisfaction Improvement Working Group

1. Background

- 1.1 The Student Satisfaction Improvement Working Group (SSIWG) was originally formed to address the National Student Survey (NSS) results, but now has a much broader remit to address student satisfaction more generally.
- 1.2 The group is intended to be very much a cooperative venture between the Association and the OU. It is jointly chaired by PVC Students and the Association President and has two further student reps as members.

2. Action Plan

- 2.1 At the June meeting of SSIWG, the group agreed that whilst some worthwhile work had been done (such as the Student Satisfaction event in January), there is a need to move to taking more concrete actions to improve student satisfaction
- 2.2 Whilst there was a general feeling that some of the work of the group so far, such as the Student Satisfaction event in January, has been worthwhile and effective, there is a desire for the group to move to taking more concrete actions to improve student satisfaction.
- 2.3 It was agreed that the student members of the group, aided and informed by other student representatives, took responsibility for constructing a revised Action Plan.

3. Relevant information sources

- 3.1 The group has an existing Action Plan, which has been modified over time. The version as of April 2019 is included as Appendix 1.
- 3.2 Appendix 2 is a copy of a document produced by the Head of Student Voice for the Student Satisfaction event in January, informed by the discussion of the student satisfaction paper that came to January CEC.
- 3.3 A consultation on student satisfaction took place on the University Students Consultative Forum in January https://learn1.open.ac.uk/mod/forumng/view.php?id=21455

4. Suggestions

- 4.1 Using the information sources listed above, the CEC are asked to discuss:-
 - Which ideas and aspects from these documents should definitely be included
 - Whether there are any aspects of the existing action plan (Appendix 1) that should be abandoned
 - Any other ideas for the Action Plan
- 4.2 The CEC are also invited to suggest whether any additional input from students other than CEC members would be appropriate
