Chat session for Hearing Impairment. April 14th

The topics for this session were Technology, Study strategies and Isolation. It is hoped to run further sessions, and hopefully get more involvement.

Microsoft ADMINS project

Some committee members have been assisting with this project to develop a Chat-Bot, currently being developed to enhance the Disabled Student Experience.

Community drop-ins

Group and committee members continue to attend these events helping students and promoting the Association and D.S.G.

Unfortunately, due to Coronavirus there are no Meet-ups happening, but committee members will be attending as many online meets and chat sessions as possible.

Conference 2020

There were some good elements to conference 2020, however not all the committee members nor the disabled students were able to use all the platforms. Some of this was technical issues, some down to scheduling. Further, more detailed feedback will follow.

Engagement

Social Media

As our social media presence continues to grow, we've also recognised that our members (including the wider OU student community) are communicating via our social media platforms. One of the targets for the next 12 months is to consider alternatives to the forums that would allow members to interact with the committee and also the wider membership network. With global pride 2020 being the same weekend as conference, we worked together with communications and engagement team in the nations and have had a lot of interactions with one of our tweets having the wales office video being seen by 8222 people and having 1704 people watch the video which is always a great start.

PLEXUS Emails/Storage

PLEXUS now have all been merged over to the new @open.ac.uk email addresses and these have been updated on the Microsite. We now have access to the Onedrive.

The committee had a catchup with Myles, and we have come up with a plan of a weekly meeting with him to have a catch up and plan what is happening the week going forward. We have asked if Myles can get access to the PLEXUS constitution and the role descriptions for the committee as we have had two students who have expressed interest for fulfilling two of the roles.

Coming Up

PLEXUS Re-Launch

Following our sit down as a committee we had come up with a few ideas of a PLEXUS relaunch they are as follows:

- PLEXUS to be renamed, with this we are planning to get a panel together comprising of the committee, 2/3 PLEXUS members and a member of the student support team to discuss this plan.
- Renaming the current newsletter 'SOLAR' and this would again be determined by the panel.
- Reshuffle of the committee and renaming some of the positions to make them easier to fill and also giving the committee members a wider portfolio.

This is still underway, the plan will be that anything the committee make a decision on this would be put out to the members so they can have their say on the proposed changes.
