1. Income and Expenditure Outturn 2018/19

- 1.1. The attached income and expenditure report (Appendix A) reports actuals for the year ended 31 July 2019. Prior year actuals are provided for comparison purposes.
- 1.2. The Association's financial position is summarised as follows:
