OU Students Association: NSS 2021 results

Table 1: The Association's %Agree and sectorwide %Agree for Q26 are compared for key demographic groupings along the variables of age, gender, disability and ethnicity. The overall gap between the Association and the sector is at 9.85% with the Association lagging; this gap is widest for students who are Mature, Female, have 'No known disability', and identify as belonging to 'Other ethnicity'. However, the gap is much smaller for students who have a 'Specific learning disability', 'Other disability', and identify as belonging to 'Mixed ethnicity'.

Table 2: The proportion of respondents showing a distinct opinion on Q26 and those satisfied from among them are shown for key student groupings. The median score for those showing a distinct opinion is at 44.58%, while the median satisfaction score is at 87.93%. Both 'distinct opinion' and 'satisfaction' scores are lower than the median for students who are Mature, Male and identify as belonging to 'White ethnicity'. Both scores are higher than the median for students who are Young and identify as belonging to Asian and Black ethnicities.
